

## How to reach Maastricht

### By Car (a route planner on website: [www.map24.com](http://www.map24.com) or [www.routenet.nl](http://www.routenet.nl))

Maastricht is situated at the motorway junction of the E25/A2 (Amsterdam-Brussels) and A79 (Liège-Aachen/Cologne) and has good connections with all European highways. The congress venue is situated directly off the European highway E25/A2. Take the Randwyck/ MECC/ AZM exit. The signs will direct you to the parking areas.

### By Air

International travelers may make train connections to Maastricht via Amsterdam or Brussels or other international arrival cities. (There are no commercial flights into Maastricht.)

**NOTE:** We recommend flying to **Brussels-Zaventem Airport** and booking the Airport Shuttle Service (€66 for a return ticket – download the Airport Shuttle Service Booking Form).

Flights from and to London, Barcelona, Rome, Milano, Madrid, Prague, Budapest, Dublin, etc.

#### 5. Charleroi Airport (website: [www.charleroi-airport.com](http://www.charleroi-airport.com))

Flights from and to Charleroi Airport: Budapest, Prague, Rome, Glasgow, Dublin, Porto, Sofia, Warsaw, Naples, Marseille, Madrid, Gerone, etc.

Railway connection to Maastricht (1 hour and 50 minutes) (website <http://www.sncb.be/>)

#### 6. Cologne-Bonn Airport (website: [www.airport-cgn.de](http://www.airport-cgn.de))

Flights from and to Cologne – Bonn airport: Amsterdam, Athens, Barcelona, Berlin, Dublin, Istanbul, Lisbon, London, Milan, Porto, Paris, Prague, Rome, etc.

Railway connection to Maastricht (1 hour and 20 minutes to Aachen, then 1 hour and 10 minutes to Maastricht. Total is 2 ½ hours)

### By Train

Please note that most trains arrive into Maastricht City Centre Station from which a taxi may be taken to the conference center and nearby hotels. However, those who wish to do so may catch a train from Maastricht City Centre Station to Randyke Station which is one stop away. From there, it is a short walk (approximately 150 meters) to the conference center and nearby hotels.
